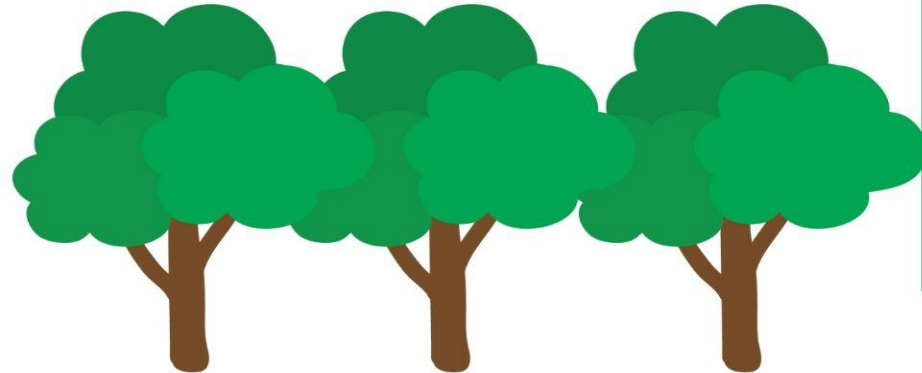

- The Green Forum is intended to provide a series of platforms for 46th Ward residents to choose environmental priorities for the year and to discuss actionable ways for the community and the City to work towards those priorities.

What We Hope to Achieve

- Share environmental concerns, voice actionable policy priorities for the Alderman, and for the Alderman's office to coordinate environmental programming within the 46th Ward
- Increase awareness around what the City has already achieved along with ongoing sustainability efforts through the Mayor's Office of Sustainability and the City Council's Environmental Committee
- Further connect 46th Ward residents with existing environmental programming offered through the City, sister agencies, and non-profit organizations

Goals for First Meeting

1. Gauge environmental priorities of 46th ward residents which will inform a ward-wide survey
2. Learn who residents want to hear from within the City of Chicago, including departments, sister agencies, and non-profit organizations
3. Identify local sustainability programming opportunities for residents

Goal 1: Gauge Environmental Priorities of Residents

- Increasing protected bike lanes and dedicated bus lanes
- Increasing stormwater management
- Increasing the tree canopy
- Protecting the lakefront
- Raising environmental standards for the building code
- Reducing car dependency
- Reducing plastic consumption
